Privacy Policy

Policy Statement:

Somerset Redstone Trust is committed and takes very seriously the protection and privacy of people who visit our website or communicate electronically with us. We are aware of our obligations under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will apply from 25 May 2018, when it supersedes the UK Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA). Significant and wide-reaching in scope, the new law brings a 21st century approach to data protection. It expands the rights of individuals to control how their personal data is collected and processed, and places a range of new obligations on organisations to be more accountable for data protection.

Information the Trust collects:

The disclosure of any personal information is not necessary to visit our website. However in operating this website we may collect and process certain data and information relating to you and your use of the site. We collect personal information from people whenever online forms are completed and every time you provide us with your email address.

Further information is automatically collected, including details of how many visits to our website and the pages and resources that are accessed. This is used to help us improve our website.

Use of Cookies:

Cookies are sometimes used to improve the website experience of a visitor to a website. We may sometimes use cookies on this website to record aggregate statistical information about the visitors to our site and the use that people make of the website. When collected this information is used by us to improve our website and further enhance your experience and being responsive to your needs and preferences.

Cookies make surfing the web easier by saving preferences and are used on all major websites. They identify which areas of a website are most popular and which are not popular.

We may also use the Cookies to gather information about your general internet use to further assist us in developing our website. Where used these Cookies are downloaded to your device automatically. The Cookie file is stored on your device e.g. desk top, iPad, tablet or laptop. Cookies contain information that is stored on your system and is then transferred to us where appropriate help us improve our website. You are able to decline or remove Cookies at any time by using the settings within your Internet Options on your device and re-setting your web

browser. If you do refuse Cookies the website may be much slower and not function in the way you would like.
